The majority of oral and maxillofacial surgery procedures are performed in the office with anesthesia administration.




Safe and comfortable

Oral and maxillofacial surgeons (OMSs) are trained to appropriately administer all forms of sedation and general anesthesia.










The anesthesia team is made up of...
